#### NOTES

Apple Computer Inc. no longer supports Mac OS 10.0.x through 10.1.4, so we can't guarantee that this newly released version of SMART Board software will run correctly on these operating systems. If you're running Mac OS 10.1.1 through 10.1.4, Apple offers free upgrades to 10.1.5, so we suggest you visit the Apple Web site.

SMART Board software version 8.0 runs best if you're also running Java Developer's Kit (JDK) software version 1.3.1 Upgrade 1.

For Mac OS 8.5 through 9.x operating system, see Basic FAQs. Note that any operating system earlier than Mac OS 9 doesn't support USB connectivity.

Version 8.0 of Notebook software also works on UNIX platforms.

#### What are the new features in version 8.0 of the software?

This release of SMART Board software includes many new features. With this version, you can:

- create an on-line movie of everything you do at the screen by using SMART Recorder. This application synchronizes data and audio into one file that you can play back using QuickTime Player.
- focus audience attention on one area of the screen with the moveable Desktop Spotlight. You can change the size and shape of the spotlight, as well as alter the transparency level of the rest of the screen.
- use SMART Ideas concept-mapping software, which is included with SMART Board software
- use multiple monitors or connect more than one SMART Board interactive whiteboard for use from one computer
- link to *SMART Board Control Panel* from your System Preferences folder
- set your own double-click zone for ease of use on your SMART interactive product

With this release of Notebook software, you can:

- link documents or Web addresses to images or text in Notebook software
- use the Screen Shade to conceal the content of your pages until you're ready to reveal it
- add templates to your pages so you can quickly insert graph paper, ruled sheets, music staves, or grid lines to enhance your lessons
- add clip art images to your pages using the clip art gallery that comes with SMART Ideas software
- group or ungroup objects that you create in close proximity with each other
- drag-and-drop objects between pages to make it easy to sort and organize your information
- stack objects on the page
- open classic Notebook files (files created on Mac OS 8.5 through 9.x operating system), including graphics
- use the Preferences feature, that saves the settings of every user of your computer so Notebook software remembers what toolbar you like, how you configured the tools and what files you recently used
