

Cliplet Support on SMART Ideas™ Software for Mac OS X Operating System Software



Applies to: SMART Ideas™ software 5.0.3 or later for Mac OS X operating system software

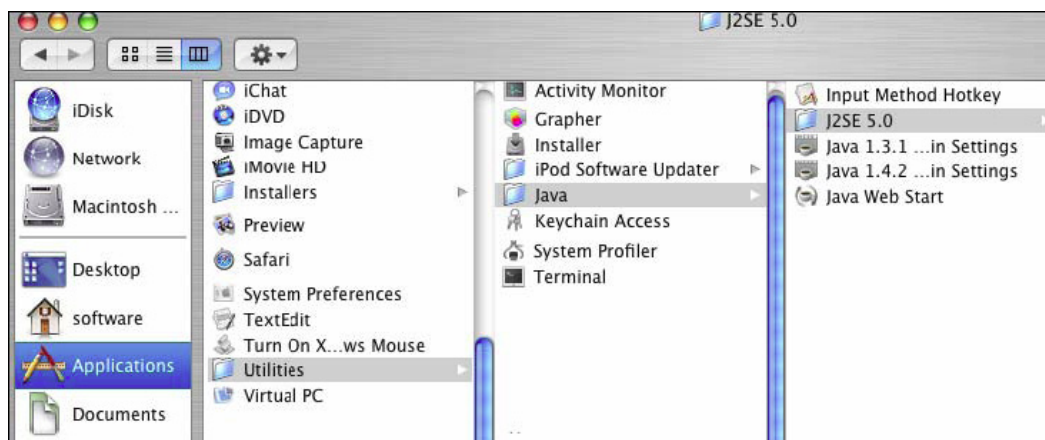
Issue

Cliplets are supported in SMART Ideas software 5.0.3 or later only if your Mac OS X operating system software is version 10.4 or later and if you've installed Sun Java™ J2SE™ 5.0 (JSE 1.5).

NOTE: Cliplets don't work in SMART Ideas software 4.0 to 5.0.2.

Solution

Cliplets require Sun Java J2SE 5.0. To find out if it is already installed browse to **Applications > Utilities > Java > J2SE 5.0**. If the folder **J2SE 5.0** exists, J2SE 5.0 is installed.

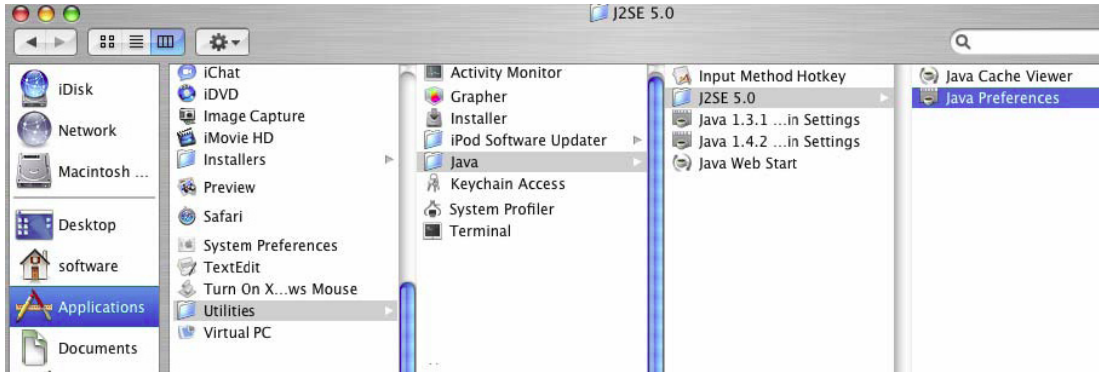


To install Java 5.0.

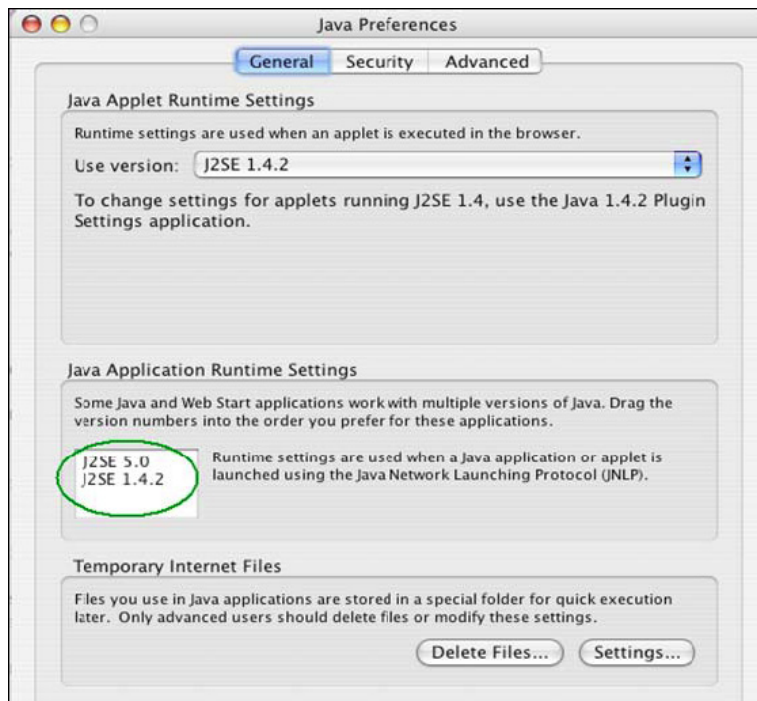
1. Download the appropriate version of the software:
 - For OS X 10.4.0 and 10.4.1 download [Java 2 SE 5.0 Release One](#).
 - For OS X 10.4.2 and later download [Java 2 SE 5.0 Release Three](#).
2. Double-click the downloaded .dmg file to install the software.
The file mounts and appears as a disk in the Finder.
3. Open the mounted disk, and then double-click the **Installer** icon.
4. Follow the onscreen instructions to complete the installation.

To configure Java 5.0.

1. Navigate to **Applications > Utilities > Java > J2SE 5.0 > Java Preferences**, and then double-click **Java Preferences**.



2. In the Java Application Runtime Settings area, drag the **J2SE 5.0** option to the top of the list, above the JSE2 1.4.2 item, and then click **Save**.



The Java Application Runtime Settings are now updated.
