

What's New in Bridgit Software Version 3

VoIP Communication

Bridgit software version 3 lets you talk and listen to other conference participants using a Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP). Up to four participants can talk at once, and any number of participants can listen to the conversation. You can optimize the audio for sound quality or for bandwidth conservation.

Improved Conference Controls

Bridgit software version 3 provides greater control over conferences by introducing the new role of conference owner, the person who creates a conference. Like the conference presenter, the owner can control desktop sharing and grant or revoke a participant's permission to speak within a conference, as well as make notes on the shared desktop, share and view webcams, and more. The owner can also optimize the VoIP settings to improve the sound quality or to conserve bandwidth.

Improved Reporting in the Bridgit Software Server Admin Tools

The Admin Tools for the Bridgit software server now let you save reports for all recorded activity or for entries you select. In addition, the report logs now include information about the participant's operating system.

User Interface Improvements

Bridgit software version 3 features updated icons and a reorganized menu. Many of the new and existing configuration options are now available from a single tabbed dialog box, making them easier to find and use.

The border in Bridgit software version 3 is now thinner as well, so there's more space on your screen for the applications you share.
