

# Using Bridgit™ Conferencing Software with Microsoft® Virtual PC Software



**Applies to:** Bridgit™ conferencing software 2.0.2 or later on both the Windows® and Macintosh operating systems

## Issue

You need information on using Bridgit conferencing software with Microsoft® Virtual PC software.

## Solution

Virtual PC is a software virtualization solution that allows you to run multiple PC-based operating systems simultaneously on one workstation. Bridgit will work in Virtual PC software on both Windows and Macintosh operating systems; however, the cursor may not always perform properly.

**NOTE FOR MAC USERS:** Virtual PC software on a Macintosh computer creates a “Windows” desktop on your screen. When you use Bridgit software in this environment, you can share only this “Windows” desktop, not the Mac desktop.
