

Symantec AntiVirus™ Software Detects a Trojan Horse in MediaCoder Installation Files



Applies to: SMART Board™ software 9.5 on Windows® operating systems

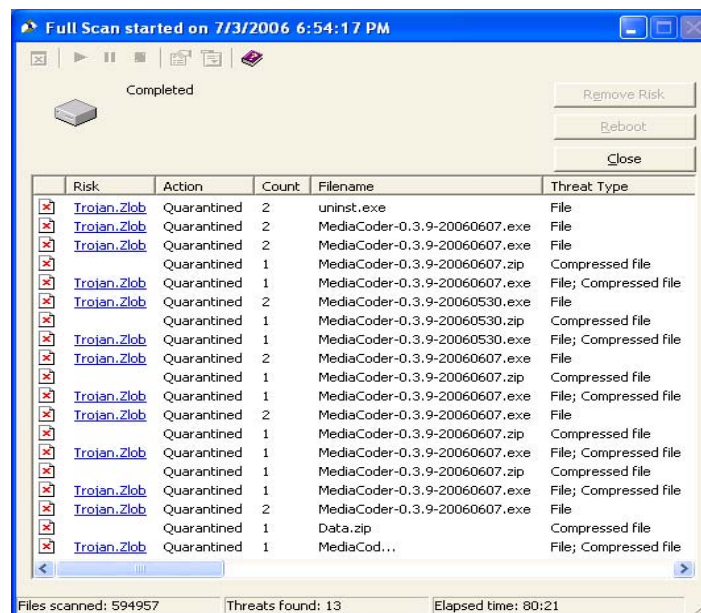
Issue

A message appears saying that Symantec AntiVirus™ software detected a Trojan horse named **Trojan.Zlob** in MediaCoder files.

Symptoms

Symantec AntiVirus software detects a Trojan horse named **Trojan.Zlob** in the MediaCoder installation files **MediaCoder-0.3.9-20060607.zip** and **MediaCoder-0.3.9-20060607.exe**.

Below is an example of a Symantec AntiVirus scan report showing the detected Trojan horse.



Cause

In early July 2006, the Symantec™ company released antivirus definitions that mistakenly detect a Trojan horse in MediaCoder 0.3.9 Full Pack (20060607) installation files. The Symantec™ company remedied this problem in virus definition file version 7/6/2006 rev. 21 released on July 6, 2006.
